- ___ Review the Red Badge Program and monitor accomplishments
- ___ Set up a breakfast or lunch meeting to talk specifically about Rotary. (One on one relating is VERY important).
- ___ Make contact when meetings are missed. (By showing concern you'll encourage good attendance and know when difficulties arise).
- ___ Socialize at meetings and encourage table rotating. (They will feel more in touch with several members).
- ___ Introduce them to guests and visiting Rotarians. (Show how you greet visitors and make them feel welcome).
- ___ Make sure they are receiving the Rotoreador. (The bulletin is great source for information).
- ___ Familiarize them with the directory of clubs around the world. (Talk about the value of visiting Clubs in other cities, states and countries).
- ___ Work together on a project. (Service involvement is the cornerstone to our organization).
- ___ Encourage District Conference and District Assembly/Education Day attendance. (Participation will increase their understanding and involvement at a new level).
- ___ Encourage participation in events sponsored by another Rotary Club. (Holiday Ball, Pancake Breakfasts, New Club Charter Nights, etc.).
- ___ Assist in choosing a committee for them to join.
- ___ Have them sign up for club parties and social events. (Involving spouses and significant others will provide opportunities for spouses to make friendships also).
- ___ Encourage them to visit the Longmont Rotary Website, along with Rotary International's Website. (Seeing the scope of Rotary will encourage them to be involved in all avenues of service)
