## PROGRAM

(Announcements Continued)

The program for the week was presented by Tim Troval, representing the FAA Air Route Traffic Control Center which is located at 17th Street and Hover in Longmont. The ARTCC was established in 1942 and the building it occupies was built in 1962. They have 600 employees, divided between controllers, managers and technicians that keep things running. The ARTCC must operate 24 hours a day, seven days a week, 365 days a year. It accomplishes this feat because of built in redundancy and the maintenance crew. The ARTCC is responsible for providing aircraft separation for aircraft on instrument flight plans over a 285,000 square mile area. They also balance the flow of aircraft through the sky, help with search and rescue and play a part in National Security and Homeland Defense.
